From the Greens Committee...

Key Points:

- * Starting January 1st thru February 15th the pro shop and golf course will be closed if the temperature is under 40 degrees. Flags will be moved off the greens to the approach area and the tees will be on the back of the teeing ground. There will be a strictly enforced **cart path only** rule during this time as well. You must call the pro shop to see what the status of the course is. It might be above 40 but conditions may not allow for play.
- * Dead Ash trees will be removed starting this month and continuing until the project is complete.
- * We have started a winter equipment maintenance program.
- * Maurice is still working on our Lastech mower.
- * We are looking into options with our old Cushman. The carburetor needs replaced and that part is hard to find. We may look into selling it. This discussion has been tabled for now. If you are interested in having your name added to a list of potential buyers let Kurt know.
