From the Greens Committee...

Key Points:

- * We are addressing concerns about carts being off the path around the greens and tee areas. Ideally we would like our members to care enough about the course to self govern. If this continues to be a problem we will look at repercussions which could include suspension of playing privileges. There will be no exceptions including Ryder Cup and President's cup matches.
- * Chemical budget for 2022 has been finalized,
- * We have purchased a vacuum primarily to pick up sweet gum balls but can be used for leaves as well.
- * We will be cutting down some dead trees this winter.
- * We are developing a winter equipment maintenance program.
- * Maurice is still working on our Lastech mower.
- * Looking at 12/1 to move tees off primary teeing ground to give them a rest from all the golf season traffic. Also implementing a winter walking or Cart Path Only (CPO) rule on 12/1.

Bylaws Revision Proposal...

I. Election of Directors

The election to the Board of Directors shall be held during August. Notice of the election shall be posted on the lobby bulletin board no later than August 1st, and by email, and as a non-required option on the club's Facebook page.. A sign up sheet posted on the lobby bulletin board will serve as the nominating process. Members have approximately 2 weeks prior to the August board meeting to sign up. If a member nominates someone other than him/herself they must have the candidate's approval.

The Board will review the list of candidates during the August board meeting and after approval the slate of candidates will be posted in the lobby, sent out by email, and, as a non-required option, posted on Facebook. Candidates must be a member in good standing and must not have a conflict of interest which may include a connection to a key employee of the club, or business interest which could enrich the candidate.

At the time of voting, voters will be permitted to write in names of candidates not listed on the ballot however, those are subject to final approval by the board should a write-in get enough votes. If the write-in is not approved the next name with the appropriate number of votes will take that spot.

Each holder of a single golf membership shall be entitled to one vote. The husband and wife of a family golf membership shall be entitled to one vote each. Member nominees must be in good standing to be eligible for board membership.

Members may vote before league on Monday from 4:30-5:30 p.m., Wednesday and Thursday from 4:00 to 5:00 p.m. and from 11:00 am to 3:00 pm on Saturday. Members may vote at the club,, or email their vote. An email address and/or contact person will be noted prior to voting. The committee will check off the names of those voting. At least one member of the board and/or one lay member chosen by the board will be on duty during the voting periods. The maximum number required to man the polls is one and can be a board member or lay member.

Votes will be tabulated at the close of the election on Saturday by at least 1 board member and a witness. In case of a tie the Board of Directors shall select the winner(s) by a majority vote of the entire board. The ballot box must remain sealed until the close of the election.

If you have any concerns about this proposed revision and would like to address the board please contact Kurt and advise him you would like to attend the meeting. Board meetings are on the second Monday of each month at 5:30.
