



2026 MEN'S LEAGUE RULES

The season will run for 20 weeks from April 23rd to September 3rd.

League dues are \$35.00 per player and \$20.00 per player for skins for the year. Teams have to decide by the first night of league for the skins. Skins are gross skins only and are team skins.

You may improve your lies everywhere except in the hazards, no closer to the hole.

- Blue tees: Ages 54 & below
- White tees: Ages 55-59
- Yellow tees: Ages 60-69
- Green tees: Ages 70+

If you turn 55, 60 or 70 during the season you must start at the new tees.

HANDICAPS

Handicaps are team handicaps and will be calculated every 5 weeks. Teams will start with the handicap they finished with the year before. Teams with two returning players will have a decision made as to adding or lowering handicaps. New teams will start with a zero handicap. If only 2 players show up for a week or a team has a substitute, a higher than average score won't count but a lower score will. Teams can substitute one player each week but his handicap has to be even or higher than the person he is subbing for. All substitutes must be documented on the card, no exceptions. Anyone subbing for a person with no handicap must be approved prior to that night. A team that is found to have a sub that was a lower handicap than the player being subbed for will forfeit the match.

SCORING

Matches will be worth 2 pts. per hole and 4 pts. for low net. Play will be 3-man net best ball versus the other team. This year you will also be playing a team in the blind for the same points. That makes each night worth a total of 44 points. In the event of a rainout, the match will be made up in the blind the next time you play that side. In case of a forfeit, the remaining team will receive 14 points.

PLAYOFFS

The playoffs will be a little different this year going back to how they used to be played. The top 4 point teams and top 4 low average teams for each night will advance to the playoffs at the end of the season. If a team qualifies for both, they will be asked to make a decision on which way they want to go. If a player qualifies with teams on both nights, he will have to decide which team he will play with. There are no substitutes in the playoffs. The first two rounds will be 9-hole matches and will be played Sept. 8th & 10th. The finals of each will be at 12:00 on Saturday, September 12th and will be 18-hole matches. Should any teams be tied at the end of regulation, they will start on #1 or #10, depending on which side they are playing, and handicap strokes will still be in effect for the point teams. If there is a tie after 18 holes in the final they will start on #1.

All members must be current with their bills to play in league
